

### Designing Your Childcare Space

THE KEY IS TO NOT COMPARE YOUR PROGRAM TO OTHERS





All providers know designing your program's environment can create a lot of anxiety and stress. It's easy to get caught up in the idea of what other providers are doing and how they're doing it. We've all been there! You see someone else's space and think "I could never do that with my budget" or "They have way more space than me". Just remember there is no right or wrong way to design a childcare space! Create your program! Be you! The wonderful thing about Childcare Facebook Groups is that you get to see all the different varieties of programs. You may see some setups that don't look anything like childcare and then on the other hand someone has the perfect preschool setup. Some providers may choose to take a minimalist approach while others go all out! You may be a provider who doesn't want your home to look like childcare at the end of the day, too. It is okay to be different. You will even see some add-on additions to the provider's home like garage additions, etc. The takeaway is that every setup is PERFECT! Find your style and go with it. Don't compare your program to others. You may also not be where you want to be design-wise and that is ok, too. Just remember a fresh coat of paint and some new curtains are inexpensive and can go a long way to change a room's dynamic. Your goal is to find out what works for you and your program. See some of the design questions below to help trigger your style.

### Questions To Ask When Designing Your Childcare Space:

What is my childcare style (color, theme, feeling)?

What can I afford?

What are my long-term design goals?

What is my timeline?

Will it be a good financial investment?

Can I remodel? Can I make my space larger?

What is my dream design?

Are my designs/furniture safe for children?

Will licensing approve my designs?

What can I fix on a shoestring budget?

Can decluttering make things better?

Every childcare provider has different needs, different resources, and different goals. You might be looking to make a big, quick, impact but know that your resources are limited. Don't give up. Just plan and build as you go. Nothing feels better than working hard and achieving the goals you have set out for yourself. Can't afford a full makeover? Buy paint one month and curtains the next! You can always work towards an awesome space that works for your business. Experiment with new things until it clicks!

### When designing a childcare space, consider the following tips:

- Create a safe and secure environment with proper childproofing measures in place.
- Use colors, patterns, and textures to create an engaging environment for children.
- · You can take screenshots of spaces you love with your phone. They can become your inspiration when it is time to move forward with your design.
- · Provide ample storage for toys, books, and organizational supplies. Keep things organized and clutter-free to maintain a clean and inviting atmosphere. Don't forget to childproof all areas, too!
- · Incorporate flexible seating and play areas that can be easily rearranged to accommodate different activities and age groups.
- Pay attention to the flow of your home when arranging furniture and decor.
- · Make sure there is adequate natural light and ventilation to promote a healthy and comfortable environment.
- Use non-toxic/durable/quality materials for furniture, flooring, and wall coverings.
- · Consider the needs of all caregivers by providing comfortable seating, storage for personal belongings, and access to necessities like water and snacks.
- · Create a welcoming and inviting atmosphere with artwork and other decorative elements.

# How Do I Advertise & Market My Childcare Business?

THE KEY IS TO KEEP THE PHONE RINGING EVEN WHEN YOU'RE FULL







There are many ways to advertise your childcare business depending on your budget and target audience. A FREE Google Business Page can be a great way to help get your business noticed locally. It allows you to provide potential customers with information about your business, such as your hours of operation, location, contact information, and more. Additionally, having a Google Business Page can help you appear higher in local search results, making it easier for customers to notice your services! You could potentially pop up first in a parent's local search for child care if you get good reviews/keep the account active. You can also use cross streets instead of your physical address when setting it up. Just Google how to do it! It is pretty easy to do, too! https://www.google.com/business

If you are on a tight budget you might consider starting with online advertising. You can use free social media platforms such as Facebook (don't forget to set up a FREE Facebook Business Page - www.facebook.com/business/help) to spread the word about your business and create content that will engage/attract potential customers. Don't forget about those local parent Facebook groups, too! Just get permission from the admin before you post!

You can also create business cards/flyers and distribute them in your local area. You can post them in relevant places such as dental/doctor offices, libraries, and community centers. If you have a bigger budget, you can consider advertising on local radio and television stations, or even running print ads in local newspapers and magazines. You might consider getting magnetic decals for your vehicle. They are inexpensive to purchase and are literally rolling billboards for your business! The link shows them as a standard size but they are custom-made to fit your vehicle type and we will even do the design layout for you! Here is the link to purchase. Finally, don't forget to leverage the power of reviews and referrals - ask your current customers to leave reviews on your website and/or your free business sites on Yelp, Google, and Facebook. You should remind them to refer your business to their friends and family, too.

Remember advertising isn't what it used to be! Trends have changed and most engagement is online! Don't be afraid to use it! There are so many free opportunities to help you get the word out now. The best advice is to continue to be consistent with your message and your brand!

When conducting a parent interview for your childcare program, it's important to gather essential information about the child and their family to ensure a good match. A child and a childcare program "match" is a two-way street. The child/family will need to match you, as much as your program needs to match their needs. Don't be afraid to ask those difficult questions, you will thank yourself later. It is also the perfect time to address any specific needs or concerns. Here are some interview questions to help you get started. You will begin to customize your interviews to meet your program's needs as you grow in the interview process.

### 1. General Information:

- What is your child's full name and age?
- What is your preferred start date for childcare?
- Are you looking for full-time or part-time care? Explain what type of care you offer & if you will adjust it to meet their needs. Make sure you think it through!
- How did you hear about our childcare program?

### 2. Schedule and Hours:

- What are your preferred drop-off and pick-up times? Do these times vary? Explain that if it is more than an occasional time change, you will need to discuss it.
- Will the schedule be consistent, or will it vary from week to week?
- Are there any specific days or times when you anticipate needing extra flexibility?
- Do you struggle with pickup times (traffic/required to work late/other)?
- Who are your backup caregivers when the child is sick? Do you have backup care if we are closed or not able to open due to an emergency?

### 3. Child's Background and Development:

- Can you tell me a little bit about your child's personality/interests/temperament?
- Does your child have any specific needs or preferences that I should be aware of?
- How would you describe your child's eating/sleeping/pottying routines?
- Is your child potty trained? What are your potty training plans, if not? Is your child in pull-ups/diapers? Share your program's potty training procedures at this time.

### 4. Parent Expectations and Preferences:

- What are your goals and expectations for your child's experience in a childcare program?
- Are there any specific values, principles, or teaching approaches that you prioritize?
- Do you have any specific requests or preferences regarding discipline or behavior management?
- Do you and your family celebrate birthdays and holidays? If not and your program celebrates ask if their child is still able to celebrate with their class. If not, will they have a backup care plan?

### 5. Health and Safety:

- Does your child have any allergies, medical conditions, or dietary restrictions?
- What is your plan for providing necessary medications or treatments if needed?
- Are there any specific safety concerns or precautions that I should be aware of?

### 6. Communication and Updates:

- How would you prefer to receive updates about your child's day and progress? Share how you like to connect and how often. Say you either like to send daily messages or pictures/do face-to-face during pickup/only really connect when needed/etc. Explain you probably send more messages in the beginning as the child/family all adjust. This gives them an expectation of how and when to expect communication from you. Don't over-promise if you are not big on communication. Also, remember communication is the key to running a successful childcare business. Find what works best for you.
- Are there any preferred methods of communication or specific times when you would like to connect?
- Are there any cultural or language considerations that may affect communication?

### 7. Other Practical Considerations:

- What are your transportation arrangements for dropping off and picking up your child? Who can pick up and drop off?
- Are there any specific items or supplies that you will provide for your child?
- Is there anything else you would like to discuss or any questions you have for me?

Remember, these questions serve as a starting point for your parent interview. Feel free to tailor and customize them based on your specific needs and concerns as a childcare provider. Additionally, be prepared to provide information about your rates, hours, qualifications, experience, daily schedule, policies, and any other relevant details to help parents make an informed decision. Every child is not a match. It is best to let parents know you are doing multiple interviews but limited on spots you can fill. Tell them you will let them know if you have a position available for them by a specific date. It will help not put you on the spot.

### TIME SPACE PERCENTAGE

### ARE YOU TRACKING YOUR TIME?

Make Sure You Track Your Time Even When Children Are Not In Your Care. It Will Help Reduce Your Taxes. You Need To Track Working Hours Plus All Hours Spent Working On Your Business.

Examples: Meal Planning, Grocery Shopping, Toy Cleaning, Organizing, Planning, Cleaning, Interviewing, Touring, Creating Documents, Phone Calls, Advertising / Marketing, Laundry For Your Childcare Business, Training, Remodeling, Repairs / Maintenance, Record-Keeping, Safety Proofing, Networking, Building A Website, Posting On Your Business Page, Researching, Decorating, Cooking, Continuing Education, & So Much More. Remember If You Are Working On Your Business, Log Those Hours!

### WHY ISN'T IT DEDUCTIBLE?

One Of The Most Confusing Aspects Of In-Home Child Care Is The Time Space Percentage. Having A Home-Based Business Changes Things Up When It Comes To Taxes. The Best Example To Understand Would Be Toilet Paper. If You Purchase Toilet Paper For Your Home & The Daycare Together Then You Have Created A Shared Supply Item. The Toilet Paper Is No Longer 100 Percent Deductible. So You Have To Calculate What Percentage. The Good News Is You Will Not Be Counting Toilet Paper Sheets. That Is Where Time Space Percentage Comes Into Play. Calculating Time-Space Percentage For Taxes Can Be A Bit Of A Tricky Process But Don't Over Think It.

### FIGURE MY TIME SPACE %

This Is Where The Extra Business Tracking Hours Come In Handy. You Will Add Your Regular Business Hours Plus The Extra Hours You Track Working On Your Business. You Will Divide That Number By 168 Hours (hours in a working week). Sample: 75 Hours Worked In A Week Divided By 168 Hours = (.45) 45%. This Number Will Be Your Time Percentage.

Now You Will Identify All The Rooms You Use For Childcare. You Will Want To Find The Square Footage Of All Rooms Used. Once You Add That Up Divide It By The Total Square Footage Of Your Home. This Is Your Space Calculation. Sample: 1500 Square Feet Total Used For Childcare. The Home Is 2500 Square Feet. You Would Take 1500 And Divide by 2500 = (.62) So It Is 62% Space Percentage.

Now You Just Multiply The Two Percentages. Sample: Time Percentage 45% X 62% = (.2790) 27% This Is Your Time Space Percentage. Back To The Toilet Paper! Now That You Have a T/S% You Can See That 27% Of It Will Be Deductible! It Also Works On Utilities, Etc. It's The Most Important Number To Know When You Have A Home Daycare! Know Yours & Make Sure You Ask Your Tax Expert How They Plan To Apply It. In-Home Childcare Taxes Are Very Different & Not Everyone Is Well Versed On Tax Laws & Deductions. Always Seek Help If You Cannot Do It Alone! Contact Us Anytime And We Will Share Tax Advisors That Understand Our Industry! We Are Not The Experts But We Do Understand In-Home Childcare!

### Be Aware That There Is Also A Time Space Calculation For Exclusive Rooms.








# glass Jan Aquanium

Creating a glass jar aquarium craft for your program is a fun and interactive activity that allows children to create their own miniature underwater world. Here are step-by-step directions to guide you through the process:

### **Materials needed:**

- 1. Glass jars with lids (one per child)
- 2. Blue, safe food coloring
- 3. Small plastic beach/sea creatures (fish, seahorses, turtles, etc.)
- 4. Decorative aquarium gravel or small rocks
- 5. Clear-drying craft glue
- 6. Water
- 7. Optional: aquarium plants, shells, or other small decorative elements

### **Instructions:**

- 1. Begin by cleaning the glass jars thoroughly. Ensure they are completely dry before starting the craft.
- 2. Invite each child to select their desired plastic beach/sea creatures to populate their aquarium. Encourage them to choose a variety of shapes and colors.
- 3. Fill the glass jar about halfway with decorative aquarium gravel or small rocks. This will serve as the substrate for the aquarium.
- 4. Add a few drops of blue food coloring to the jar. The food coloring will give the water a more realistic aquatic appearance. Adjust the amount of food coloring based on the desired shade of blue.
- 5. Have the children place their selected beach/sea creatures and any additional decorative elements inside the jar, arranging them as desired.
- 6. Fill the jar with water, leaving some space at the top to avoid overflow when the lid is screwed on. Make sure not to fill the jar to the brim.
- 7. Apply clear-drying craft glue to the inner rim of the jar's lid to ensure a secure seal. Screw the lid tightly onto the jar.
- 8. Once the lid is secure, show the children how to gently shake or tilt the jar to create the illusion of swimming sea creatures and moving underwater scenery.
- 19. Encourage the children to observe and discuss the contents of their jar aquariums, asking questions about the sea creatures and their imaginary underwater environment.


